Originally known as Round Hill the town's name was changed in 1770 to commemorate the bicentennial of Cook's visit. The 1770 Dragons are lucky enough to call this beautiful and historic place home, training in the estuary while watching dolphins play and the sun set over the distant hills. The team has won first place overall in the 2011, 2013 and 2015 Wide Bay Regional Regatta Series and competes in State and National regattas. The crew trains year round and consists of paddlers of all ages, and all are welcome to come and give it a go.
