Formed on January 17, 2007, the club covers membership for all ages and is committed to fun, fitness and friendship. Our aim is to enjoy the sport of dragon boating, while encouraging and assisting our members to achieve their individual goals of fitness and competition.

We have club members who are committed to achieving State and National representative teams, as well as those who wish to paddle purely for the social and general fitness it offers. Our club participates in Queensland Dragon Boat Federation (QDBF) calendar activities. These include team regattas, long distance competitions, State Championships and each year our club strives to compete at the Australian National Dragon Boat Championships.

Grants have enabled us to buy 2 20-person racing boat, life-jackets and two double boat trailers. In 2012 we purchased a ten-person boat, which allows the training of smaller groups to paddle mid week. The Redland City Council has leased us a parcel of land for use as a club at Redland Bay, and we are dedicated to building our future club house and boat shed on this site. Our mission is to inform and inspire our members to embrace the uniqueness and excitement of team sports in the Redlands.

This year Redlands Sea Dragons will participate in **13** regattas, State, National and International Regattas/Championships, Redlands Super Sports Sunday, Relay for Life, Cancer Council, Red Fest Lantern Parade, and Flinders Day on Coochiemudlo Island, Victoria Point Shopping Mall Sports Display, Tweed River and all organised and managed by the members.

Free come and Try paddling sessions are held on the first Sunday of each month. No experience is necessary, just a willingness to have fun, work as a team, enjoy our Bay, and possibly get wet. We meet up at 6:30am to sign on at the clubhouse. Weekend paddling sessions are followed by a social get together for a coffee and chat at the local café, located at the Pelican's Slipway.
